The Chedi Andermatt reopens for summer on 26 May 2022 with new offerings

High Altitude Safari

For those seeking a summer adventure that is family-friendly, The Chedi Andermatt's High Altitude Safari allows adult and children to explore gorges, trails and peaks of Andermatt in the company of an expert mountain guide. Equipped with picnics prepared by The Restaurant, families will set off on local walks and hikes to spot the 'Big Five' of the Swiss Alps - marmots, goats, llamas, chamois

and falcons - whilst learning about the local flora. During the hike, guests will pick fresh herbs to take back to the hotel, and prepare their own alpine pesto with The Chedi Andermatt's chefs.

Digital Detox

Designed to counteract a perpetually connected lifestyle, that increased exponentially during the pandemic, the Digital Detox package invites guests to slow down and switch off during a three-night stay. During the trip, guests have the option to turn in their mobile phones and fully disconnect, whilst tuning into self-care, with yoga sessions, meditation, detoxing massages and a silent hike through the Orsera Valley.

Luxury Pit Stop

For guests who want to (re)discover their inner James Bond, this experience invites adrenaline-seekers to speed around the hairpin bends immortalised in Mission Goldfinger, in a Morgan 4x4. During a two-night stay, guests will spend one day on a driving tour with The Chedi Roadbook, as well as enjoying a four-course dinner at The Japanese or The Restaurant, plus a relaxing massage for both guests at the award-winning Spa.
