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The Chedi Andermatt makes record result in 2021



Andermatt/Zollikon, 30 March 2022 – The Chedi Andermatt has been making an operating profit (GOP) since 2018, and in 2021 continued its success story with another record result. Last year this 5-star deluxe hotel had a record overall occupancy of 70 percent (2020: 69 percent). Revenues rose by 26 percent over the previous year to CHF 43.5 million (2020: CHF 34.5 million). All told, last year The Chedi Andermatt welcomed 64,887 guests, an increase of around 17 percent over 55,242 guests in 2020. www.thechediandermatt.com

Since 2021 this highest-altitude Japanese restaurant in the Alps has also had a prestigious Michelin star. Another highlight was the 2021 VINUM award for the best wine list of 2021, for the third year in a row.
